### About the Enterprise Employee Scholarship Fund

- **Mission:** The mission of the Enterprise Employee Scholarship Fund is to provide additional financial assistance to individuals who have demonstrated significant leadership potential and who are enrolled, or plan to become enrolled, in a degree program from an accredited university in the United States.
- **Offerings:** This enterprise-wide initiative will offer talented and committed employees an opportunity to earn an initial degree, or an advanced degree. Employees of the University, MUHA and MUSC Physicians with at least two years of employment are all eligible to apply for scholarship funding.
- **Application Deadline:** Applications will be accepted once per year during an open enrollment period. Typically, this will be June 1 to June 30. In 2018, the first enrollment period will be May 22 through June 30. You can access the [application form here](#) on the Horseshoe
