Question an Answers

- Q-45 Is MUSC looking for a vendor to operate a "virtual bookstore" that provides and sells *all* of the merchandise categories in answer A1 of the Amendment? This would mean the vendor will sell not just textbooks and course materials, but also a full line of general merchandise items ranging from medical supplies to sundries and convenience items like a traditional brick and mortar store would. Or...
 - Is MUSC looking for a vendor to operate a "virtual bookstore" that only sells textbooks and required course materials for its students?
- A-45 The response to Question 1 provides historical sales data. However, MUSC is not seeking a vendor to operate a "virtual bookstore: that provides and sells ALL of the merchandise categories in answer A1 in Amendment 1. We understand that many of the categories that have been provided historically are not typically offered in a "virtual bookstore". As long as the vendor meets the needs of the academic community related to required textbooks and course materials and are in accordance to the trademark license agreement for MUSC branded merchandise, we will not restrict any offerings that the vendor would like to present.
