

New lactation pods on MUSC's Charleston campus

We are pleased to announce the installation of two new [Mamava lactation pods](#) at MUSC. These private spaces are designed to provide a comfortable and discreet environment to pump or nurse.

One of the new lactation pods is in the first-floor lobby of the MUSC Shawn Jenkins Children's Hospital and the Pearl Tourville Women's Pavilion. It's across from registration next to the stork elevator.

The other lactation pod is in Ashley River Tower (ART) on the fifth floor in the corridor alcove across from the bathrooms. Both pods are equipped with a comfortable chair, a fold-down laptop desk, a shelf, a mirror and a standard outlet with two USB ports.

Last year, we added Mamava lactation pods to the first-floor lobby of ART and the first-floor lobby of the Main Hospital Extension. Those pods continue to be available for use.

Parents can find and unlock the pods with a touch of a button using the (free) [Mamava app](#). (View a screenshot below.) The app not only unlocks the pods but also shows whether they are vacant or in use. If you forgot your phone or don't have the app, enter 8008# on the keypad to unlock the pod.
