Dr. Mark Sothmann called on Dr. Etta Pisano to introduce the speaker. Dr. Pisano was pleased to introduce Dr. Fred Crawford who served as Chair of MUSC's Department of Surgery from 1988 to 2007 and is now a Distinguished University Professor. He came to MUSC from the University of MS and served as MUSC's Chief of the Division of Cardio-thoracic surgery for 9 years. His goal was to develop a reference which could be used by future generations of historians; as well as, students, residents and faculty. ## Item 7. Medical University Hospital Authority Financial and Statistical Report

Mr. John Cooper, Director of Finance, reported on the Authority's financial status as of December 2013. At the end of December, operating margin was at 3.74% compared to 1.1% for the same period last year. Cash on hand was at \$51M which equates to 18 days of cash. Cooper reported that closing on the Central Energy Plant refinancing was finalized on December 30. Next week the line of credit will be renewed which will be a good back up for any issues with Epic, ICD-10 conversion and possible storm season.

## .Item 8. Report on Quality and Patient Safety

Dr. Danielle Scheurer, Chief Quality Officer, presented the Quality Report which included the Annual Medical Staff Peer Review and the Annual Sentinel Event Review Updates.

Scheurer announced that the MUSC Medical Center has been chosen as one of five hospitals in the country for a site visit by the American Hospital Association to be in the running for their Quest for Quality award. MUSC was also recently awarded certification in breast care and a recent unannounced Joint Commission validation survey was conducted with no findings.

Annual Peer Review - Scheurer reported on the analysis of closed cases for the period of January 2011 – December 2013. She explained that all cases are evaluated on two criteria: quality of care and professionalism (Policy C-105). Each case is then rated on their "level of concern" under each of the criteria. Scheurer reported there been a total of 151 cases in the past 36 months. Dr. Scheurer emphasized that approximately 700 physicians had no cases; 88 had 1 case; 8 had 2 cases; 2 had 3 cases; 3 had cases and 1 physician had 6 cases and this physician is no longer at MUSC. Dr. Scheurer commented that if a clinical chair goes into peer review, then the Dean of the College of Medicine is personally involved in the action plan.

Annual Sentinel Review - Scheurer reminded the board of the JC definition of sentinel event. A sentinel event is an unexpected occurrence involving death, serious physical or psychological injury, or the risk thereof. For 2013, there were 15 sentinel events and 27 serious events. Any event determined to be serious is evaluated and requires a 45 day action plan. The Administrative Review Group (ARG) makes a determination of whether an event is considered sentinel. Scheurer reported that in 2013, there was an average of 1000 events reported each month with the majority (90%) of those events being patients related. The remaining 10% are related to unsafe conditions. In 2013, we saw an increase in near misses and a decrease in harm which Scheurer commented that this is what a hospital wants see with event reporting.

Scheurer stated that the Medical Center continues to have a policy on notifying the patient or family of any sentinel event. Sentinel events are also evaluated to determine if they are related to staffing issues. Scheurer reported that evaluations indicate that staffing levels played no part in any of our sentinel events. The most frequent issues related to sentinel events were retained items outside the OR, high risk with human error and IV infusions. For serious events it was the lack of standardization of practice; transfers within MUSC and the lack of a single EMR which is one of the reasons we are moving toward an enterprise-wide electronic medical record. Improvements over 2012 include a decrease in errors with chemotherapy safety, OR retained items; high level disinfectants and sterile processing; ID bands; chain of command and professionalism. Actions taken to improve patient safety in 2013 included Culture of Safety, Professionalism, Just Culture, Safety Rounds and structured handoffs. Opportunities for 2014 include the enterprise-wide EMR; human factor engineering and daily safety calls or huddles.
