Item 15. Financial Status Report of the Medical University of South Carolina.

<u>Statement:</u> Mr. Patrick Wamsley, CFO, MUSC, presented the University's financial report through March 2019. He reported 134 Days of Operating Cash and an Operating Budget margin of 5.18% for March 2019 Interim University Financial Statements.

Mr. Wamsley discussed how non-cash transactions such as the booking of pension expense, unfunded retiree health benefits expenses and depreciation expenses affected the all-funds financial statements (SRECNP). He reported a negative SRECNP margin of 3.96% but noted that without the effects of the non-cash pension and OPEB expenses, the margin would have been positive .32%.

Item 16. Financial Status Report of MUSC Physicians.

Statement: Mr. Wayne Harris, Controller, presented the MUSC Physicians financial report through March 2019. Charges are up about \$70 million year over year and are currently 3.7% ahead of budget. Collections are up \$16 million which is a 4.9% increase over budgeted numbers. Days in A/R are at 36, an improvement of 4 days over last year. Operating Margin is currently at 10.6% and Days Cash on Hand is 256 which is an increase of 10 days year over year. All debt covenants are current and in compliance.
