projects from 672 gifts. In addition, MUSC received in-kind donations including: supplies and PPE from more than 300 people and organizations; meals from various individuals, restaurants and other businesses; face shields from Apple; 150,000 goggles and protective face shields from Boeing; and, three loaner cards for team members who were without transportation. The Development Office also focused efforts on raising awareness of MUSC's COVID-19 efforts including expanding social media reach and "Giving Tuesday Now on May 5, 2020, that was a national day of giving that MUSC raised \$100,081, a 25% increase over last year.
