Mr. Patrick Wamsley, CFO, presented the February 28, 2021, interim financials. At the end of December, days of cash on hand were 158. The budgeted funds margin was \$34.5 favorable which equates to a budgeted funds margin percentage of 5.85%. Operating revenues were favorable at \$16.5M and operating expenses were a favorable \$20.9M.

Ms. Eva Greenwood, Chief Financial Officer, presented the February 28, 2021, interim financials. Ms. Greenwood reported Days cash on hand remain steady and strong at 236 days. The operating margin is favorable at \$20.6M and the operating margin percentage compared to budget is 4.55%. Operating revenue is \$26M favorable with an operating expense of \$3M favorable.

Dr. Willette Burnham-Williams introduced Drs. Marvell Ford and Cristina Lopez, who presented on the South Carolina Clinical and Translation Research Institute (SCTR) Integrating Special Populations (ISP). The objective of ISP is to leverage ongoing activities and implement new statewide initiatives to encourage and enable research in diverse populations and dedicate resources to sustain critical partnerships. 2020 accomplishments include conducted the first virtual Lunch and Learn on Health Disparities surrounding COVID19; completed 2 PEG and 5 consultations for research teams; working with Interpreter Services to offer interpretation for research, with the aim on increasing diversity in clinical trials; and, expanding to offer Cultural Humility training on a virtual platform. D&I credit is offered for participating in this training. ISP's specific aims for 2020 – 2025 will include 1) developing, demonstrating and disseminating innovative strategies to overcome barriers to CTR awareness and participation for underrepresented communities; and 2) providing consultation, training and innovative resources to investigative teams to enhance recruitment and inclusion of special populations in CTR. Dr. Ford also gave an overview of anticipated barriers with ISP and potential opportunities.
